


Average Annual Employment Change Q4 2001 - Q4 2007





Average Annual Employment Change Q4 2007 - Q4 2010




Employment Change Q4 2007 - Q4 2010

Percent Population Change, 2000 - 2010




Percent Pop. Change



Employment - Population Ratio, 2010




Emp. - Pop. Ratio, 2010








Unemployment Rate, 2008










