Federal Funding for South Carolina Corridors in Fiscal Year 2012

In fiscal year 2012, South Carolina was apportioned \$6,697,663 from the Surface Transportation Act of 2011 for use on their ADHS Corridor.

Fiscal Year 2012 Obligations

During fiscal year 2012, South Carolina obligated \$338,760 federal funds on the ADHS. This included \$167,324 from SAFETEA-LU funds and \$171,436 from TEA-21 funds.

Status of Corridor

Corridor W (U.S. 25)

Corridor W runs from I-85 at Greenville north to the North Carolina State line. The total length of the corridor is 30.7 miles.

Construction Under Way


