#### **Education and Workforce Statistics in Kentucky: Data to Inform Policy & Practice in Appalachian Kentucky and Statewide**

Overview of national efforts to develop and use longitudinal data systems and of newly formed KY Center for Education and Workforce Statistics to evaluate education and workforce programs to better inform public policy and practice. Data presentation re: differences between Appalachian and non-Appalachian Kentucky, the matriculation levels of students through K-12 and into college, teacher preparation, college success, and employment outcomes of our graduates and others relative to KY’s statewide and regional employment needs. Presenter will share findings from his recent study of the out-migration of Appalachian college graduates and what it may mean for the future educational attainment levels of the region.
