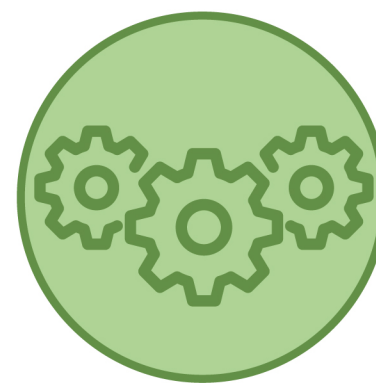
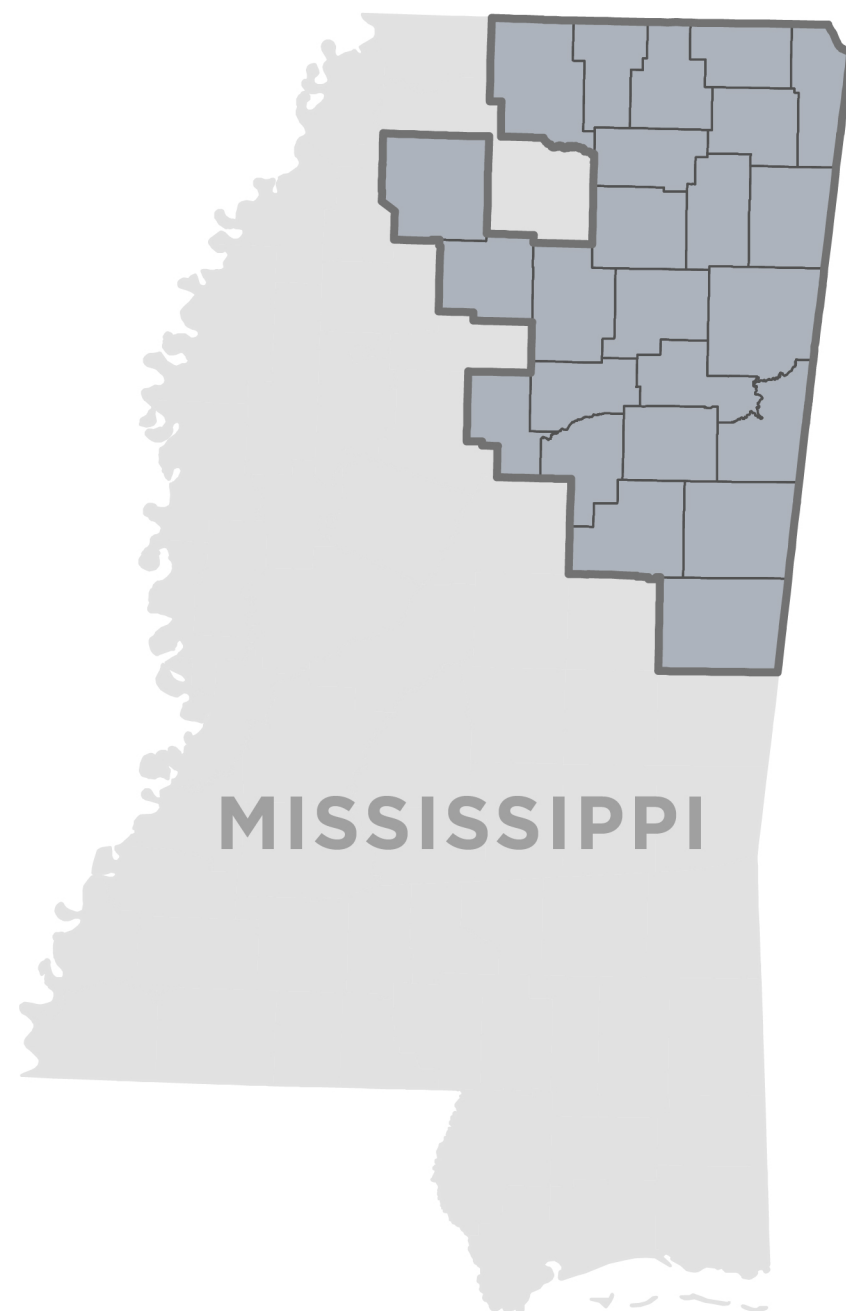

Industrial snapshot: **Appalachian Mississippi**

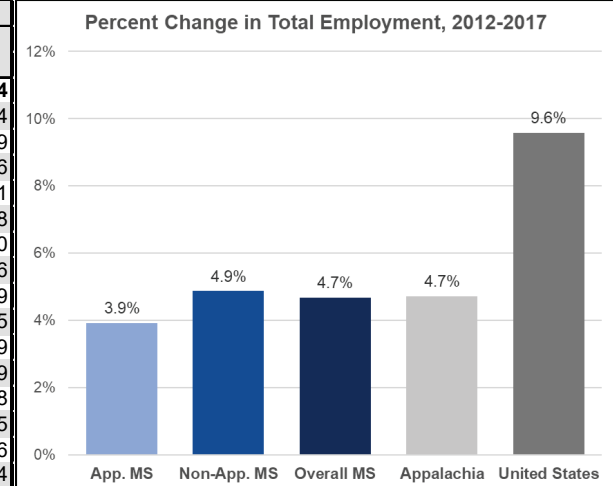
Largest industrial share in 2017: **Manufacturing**, 51,000 jobs, 16 percent of total employment
