
Population Change in Appalachia, 2000–2009

(Population Change as a Percentage of the 2000 Population)



Population change is the difference between the 2000 population estimates base and the 2009 population estimate expressed as a percentage of the 2000 population estimates base.

U.S. average = 9.1% Appalachian average = 5.7%
