LABOR FORCE PARTICIPATION

72.7%

of Appalachia's working-age adults (ages 25-64) participate in the civilian labor force. The U.S. rate is 77.4%. LABOR FORCE PARTICIPATION BY SUBREGION

Labor force participation is highest in Northern Appalachia, at 75.5%. It's lowest in Central Appalachia, at 59.5%.
