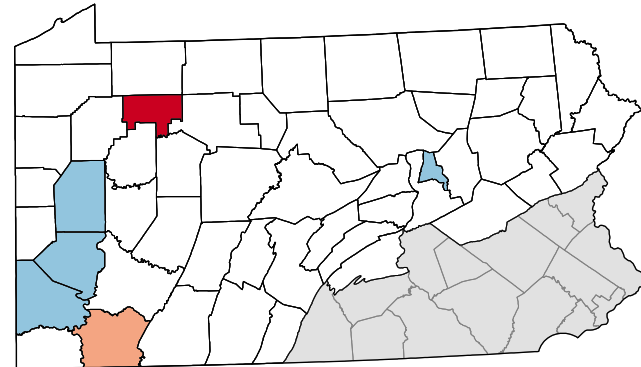

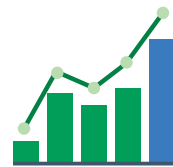
### FISCAL YEAR 2022 INVESTMENT PRIORITIES



#### WORKFORCE ECOSYSTEM

**\$12.5M**

invested in Pennsylvania to expand community systems that will help Appalachians obtain a job, stay on the job, and advance their careers



#### BUILDING BUSINESSES

**\$5.5M**

invested in entrepreneurship and business development to strengthen the economy in Appalachian Pennsylvania



#### COMMUNITY LEADERS & CAPACITY

**\$2.7M**

invested in growing the capacity of local leaders, organizations, and communities to address challenges and create opportunities in Pennsylvania



#### ADDITIONAL PRIORITIES

**\$4.7M**

invested to ensure access to reliable and affordable broadband, clean water and updated wastewater systems, and highways and preserve Pennsylvania's local history, culture, and natural assets
