



Private-sector employment in Appalachian South Carolina

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This report provides an overview of private-sector employment in Appalachian South Carolina. All data featured in the report come from [data-Fab](#), which uses a proprietary algorithm to estimate industry-specific employment values for each county in the United States. In many cases, due to data suppression issues, public datasets do not provide the level of detail required (i.e., industry-specific estimates) to perform meaningful analyses of geographies with low population or employment levels (i.e., many rural counties).

Data-Fab uses publicly available data from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics—the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW)—and then “fills in” unknown or suppressed values. The resulting dataset, featured throughout this report, allows for industry-specific employment estimates.

Without a dataset that “fills in” these missing values, discussion surrounding county-level employment can oftentimes be limited to only high-level, broad categories such as “Manufacturing.” With data-Fab, however, 91 industries are examined—and in the case of manufacturing, 18 specific types of manufacturing are included as distinct categories (e.g., “Paper Manufacturing” and “Transportation Equipment Manufacturing”). Descriptions of each industry are available by clicking on the links in Table 6 below.

In addition to state-specific reports (such as this one), a spreadsheet is available on ARC’s website, where users can create custom data pulls that compare geographies and industries of particular interest.

Figure 1 compares **changes in total employment** levels from 2016 to 2021 across five geographies.

Appalachian South Carolina saw an increase of 7.1% over the time period, compared to growth of 5.3% in the non-Appalachian portion of the state. The United States as a whole and the Appalachian Region both experienced increases in total employment, as well, at 1.8% and 0.4% growth, respectively.

Figure 1 – Employment change, 2016 to 2021

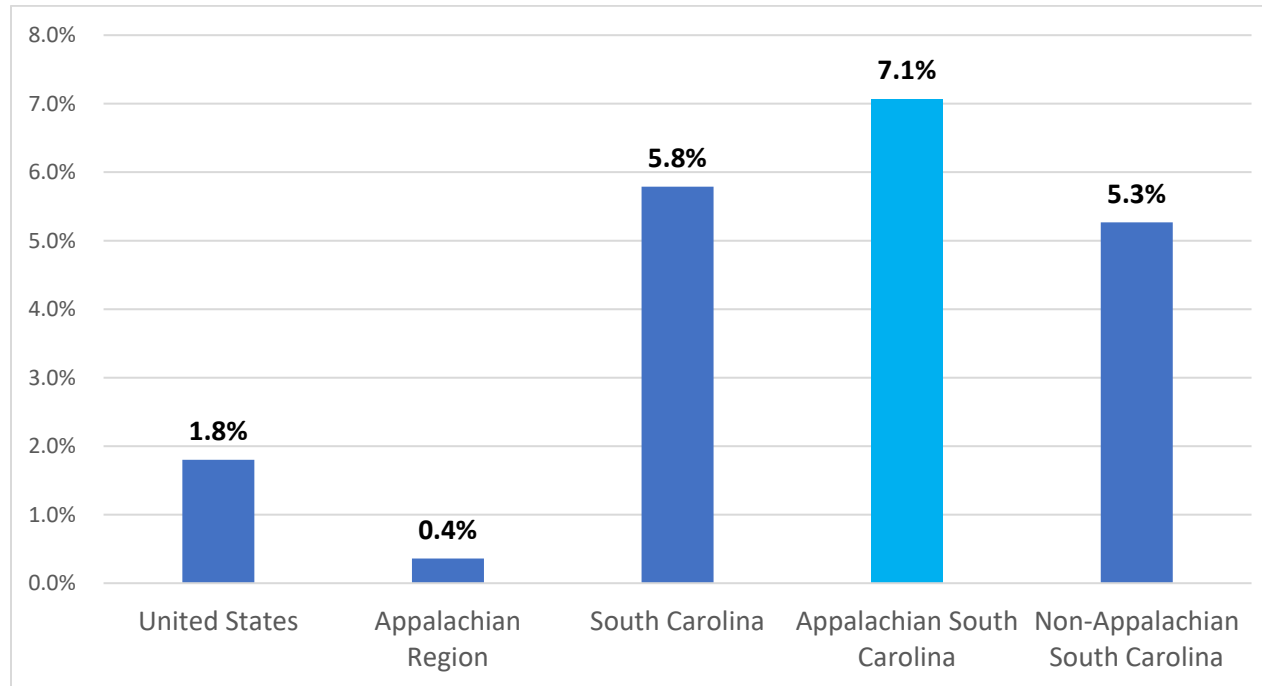


Table 1 ranks industries by **employment levels** in 2021.

Also included in the table are **industrial shares**, which represent the percentage of total employment constituted by any given industry. For example, in 2021, **Administrative and Support Services** accounted for 11.0% of total employment in Appalachian South Carolina.

Two **employment change** variables are also included: **number** and **percent**. The aforementioned industry—**Administrative and Support Services**—saw a 1.6% increase in employment from 2016 to 2021, representing a gain of 882 jobs.

Table 2 ranks industries by **employment change**, in **absolute** terms (i.e., the number of jobs added or lost), from 2016 to 2021.

The top ten rows display the industries that had the largest *increases* over the time period. **Transportation Equipment Manufacturing** saw the largest growth, gaining 6,461 jobs over the five-year span.

The bottom ten rows display the industries that had the largest *decreases* over the time period. **Wholesale Electronic Markets and Agents and Brokers** saw the largest decline, losing 1,496 jobs from 2016 to 2021.

Table 3 ranks industries by **employment change**, in **relative** terms (i.e., percent change), from 2016 to 2021. Quick note: only industries that had at least a 0.5% industrial share in 2016 are included in the table; otherwise, industries with low employment numbers would dominate the table (e.g., an industry jumping from 2 to 4 employees is a 100% increase).

The top ten rows display the industries that had the largest relative *increases* over the time period. **Warehousing and Storage** saw the largest growth, going from 5,015 jobs in 2016 to 8,488 in 2021. These 3,473 added jobs represent growth of 69.3%.

The bottom ten rows display the industries that saw the largest relative *decreases* over the time period. **Heavy and Civil Engineering Construction** saw the largest decline, dropping from 4,505 jobs in 2016 to 3,414 in 2021. These 1,091 lost jobs represent a decrease of 24.2%.

Table 4 ranks industries by **location quotient** in 2021. Location quotients allow us to see how specialized industries are in Appalachian South Carolina relative to the United States as a whole. They are calculated by simply dividing industrial shares in Appalachian South Carolina by industrial shares for the country overall.

For example, in Appalachian South Carolina, there were 16.1x as many employees—in relative terms—in **Textile Mills** in 2021 than in the United States as a whole. (The industrial share for the industry was 1.3% in Appalachian South Carolina, compared to 0.08% in the United States as a whole.)
