PROJECT SUMMARY

This project will support participating state electrical cooperatives and municipal utilities efforts to modernize electric systems and lead to more reliable, affordable, resilient, and energy-efficient utilities in the impacted areas. Beneficial Electrification League (BEL) will work closely with local and regional partners, including utilities, to develop feasibility studies and metrics for evaluating, and ultimately applying for, relevant federal funding programs.

BEL and partners bring a total of \$500,000 in matching funds to this project. The project will serve 17 businesses and result in 12 studies/applications over the course of 12 months.
