PROJECT SUMMARY

This project will identify 50 communities and provide support to help them develop digital equity master plans that will be used to seek funding for digital equity projects. These plans will help underserved communities better compete for the \$45 billion of Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment (BEAD) and Digital Equity Act (DEA) funding. Connect Humanity will coordinate with project partners to develop these locally informed and tailored digital equity plans.

Connect Humanity and their partners bring \$1,630,405 of in-kind matching funds to the project. The project will produce 50 plans that will improve the respective communities over the course of the 24-month performance period.
