

PROJECT SUMMARY

This project will integrate work-based experiential learning co-designed and co-delivered by regional healthcare and manufacturing industry partners and local education systems to prepare students for the high-skill and high wage workforce needs of the region. The project will enhance equity for underserved students in the region by providing career exploration opportunities and wrap-around services that reduce barriers to entry into the post-secondary workforce and further education. Students will be able to explore the following industry pathways: Manufacturing Production, Industrial Maintenance, Certified Medical Assistant/Ambulatory Care, and Sterile Processing Technician. The project will include paid internships for participating high-school seniors providing opportunities for direct employer connection and skill development across industry partners.

The Education Alliance and partners bring a combined \$5,891,353 of matching funds to the project. The project will implement seven career pathway programs and serve 2,605 students across the three-year period of performance.
