

PROJECT SUMMARY

This project will create a comprehensive substance use disorder (SUD) recovery-to-work employer toolkit that can be implemented by both large and small employers across 202 counties in six Appalachian states. Partners will formulate a delivery model by working with various state chambers of commerce to reach each state's largest employers, and local development districts and community-based recovery organizations to reach smaller employers.

Upper Cumberland Development District and partners bring \$281,833 in matching funds to this project. The project will generate one plan, serve 60 businesses, and 202 communities over the course of 12 months.
