PROJECT SUMMARY

East Tennessee State University (ETSU) and its regional public college and university (RPCU) partners will work collaboratively across 6 states and 235 counties to develop actionable and sustainable plans to implement healthcare worker training opportunities. Using ARC ARISE grant funding, ETSU and partners will complete a healthcare workforce training and needs gap analysis, a literature review of promising practices for engaging students, an implementation plan, and a website that will include information about the consortium and a comprehensive listing of health training programs across partner institutions.

ETSU and partners bring a combined \$109,359 in matching funds to this project. They will complete four plans/reports by the end of the 12-month performance period.
