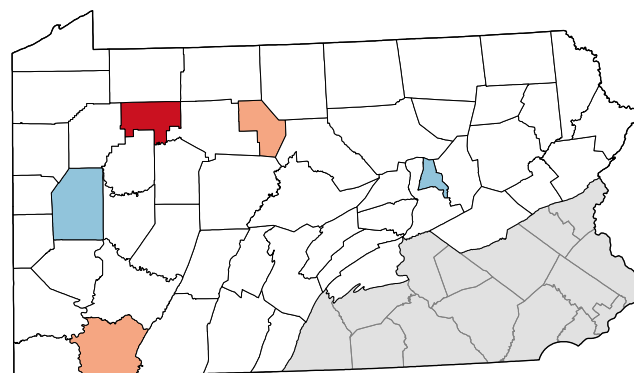

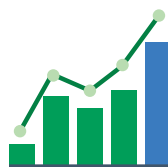
FISCAL YEAR 2024 INVESTMENT PRIORITIES



WORKFORCE ECOSYSTEM

\$16.4M

\$9M

invested in entrepreneurship and business development to strengthen the economy in Appalachian Pennsylvania



COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE

ADDITIONAL PRIORITIES
