PROJECT SUMMARY

Rural Health Redesign Center Organization, Inc., will use ARISE funding to deliver technical assistance for under-resourced healthcare systems and providers across 66 counties in Appalachian New York and Pennsylvania. By enhancing access to technical assistance, this project aims to retain and create healthcare jobs—and facilitate the development of new payment approaches that both improve health outcomes and reduce costs for providers, patients, and communities.

Rural Health Redesign Center Organization, Inc., and partners bring a combined \$5,020,513 in matching funds to this project, which will develop 60 reports, implement 16 programs, retain 550 jobs and create 50 new jobs during the four-year performance period.
