

#### COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE

**\$25.4M**

invested in Ohio to ensure access to reliable and affordable broadband, clean water and updated wastewater systems, highways and more



#### WORKFORCE ECOSYSTEM

**\$5.4M**

invested in Ohio to expand community systems that will help Appalachians obtain a job, stay on the job and advance their careers



#### COMMUNITY LEADERS & CAPACITY

**\$3.1M**

invested in growing the capacity of local leaders, organizations and communities to address challenges and create opportunities in Ohio



#### ADDITIONAL PRIORITIES

**\$3.1M**

invested in bolstering economic opportunities from local history, culture and natural assets and in entrepreneurship and business development to strengthen the economy in Ohio
