


#### COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE

**\$6.7M**

invested in Virginia to ensure access to reliable and affordable broadband, clean water and updated wastewater systems, highways and more



#### REGIONAL CULTURE & TOURISM

**\$3.4M**

invested in bolstering economic opportunities from Virginia's local history, culture and natural assets



#### COMMUNITY LEADERS & CAPACITY

**\$3.2M**

invested in growing the capacity of local leaders, organizations and communities to address challenges and create opportunities in Virginia



#### ADDITIONAL PRIORITIES

**\$2.1M**

invested in entrepreneurship and business development to strengthen the economy in Virginia and expand community systems that will help Appalachians obtain and stay on a job and advance their careers
